Laws and regulations have been enacted to protect children on the internet. These laws include the Children's Internet Protection Act (CIPA enacted in 2000) and the Children's Online Privacy Protect Act (COPPA updated July 2013). Before students under the age of 13 use selected and approved educational websites, parents must give their permission.

Our Media Center uses websites, Web 2.0 tools (some examples are Easybib, Edmodo, Glogster, MobyMax, Noodletools, Type to Learn, and Wordle), Follett E-Books, and Google Apps for Education to enhance your child's educational experience, to increase his/her engagement in learning, and to prepare your child for the 21st century. Some of these tools require a username and a password in order to access the site and to use its contents. We have assigned each student a username that starts with OLA and includes four numbers and a password that starts with student and includes four numbers. **No personal information is used.**
Example Username: ola1234 Password: student1234.
