We are always in need of lunch servers. If you can spare one hour, from 11:15 – 12:15, please stop by the kitchen and give us a hand. Every Tuesday is Token Day. That is the day you should send in your check or cash to purchase tokens. However, **if you have run out of tokens on Tuesday, your child must pay cash for that day's lunch.** Your child will not receive tokens in time for lunch that day.

Lunch price remains at \$2.25 this year! Cash is accepted, but tokens are highly preferred and encouraged. If a student forgets a token or cash, they will receive the hot lunch to eat and an IOU slip to bring home. Please send in the token or cash the next school day with the IOU slip. Your child should bring these to the cafeteria at their lunch time and give it to the person collecting tokens. Grades 5-8 students are allowed three IOU's a year. They will then receive a cheese or jelly sandwich and fruit, instead of the hot lunch. An IOU will also be given. This is not a new procedure. It has been in place for many years. Token borrowing affects the entire lunch period because it causes long lines and additional paperwork. Grades 1-4 are not limited, but must pay back all borrowed tokens. Beginning Monday, September 20, ice cream treats and bottled water will be sold. Water will be .50¢ and sold every day during lunch. Ice cream treats will be sold on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays for .50 ¢. Selections vary, but typical selections will be ice cream sandwiches, Hoodsies, popsicles, fudge stix. All products are from Hood and are peanut and nut free. Sugar free products can be added if there are requests. Please contact Paula Maylor in the kitchen for these. Ice cream will be sold to students after they have eaten their lunch. Tokens may not be used to purchase ice cream.
